A BIT OF HISTORY



deally located just a stone's throw from the Basilica of Fourvière, in Lyon's 5th arrondissement, **discover the Forum Fourvière**: the new event space at the eponymous 4-star hotel.

Almost adjoining the hotel, the Forum Fourvière offers a reception area that can accommodate up to 200 people depending on the layout.

In this fully renovated building, discover a private garden covering over 600m², a large plenary room measuring 200m² and a 45m² meeting room.

Construction of the property at 31 Rue Roger Radisson in Lyon's 5th arrondissement. Part of the building is built against the remains of the Roman Aqueduct of Gier, which is over 2,000 years old.

1850-1856

The place is operated as a guesthouse and restaurant.

People dine there, play boules and organise weddings and banquets.

1861-1906

The hospitality business ceased and

1929-1932

the building was divided into five dwellings.

iddle 1964

The pillars of the Gier Aqueduct, which lean against the building, are protected and listed as Historic Monuments (construction dates back to the middle of the 1st century AD).

2025

The èhôtels-Collection group is renovating the building to create a unique event space in Lyon. It is operated by the Fourvière Hotel, a 4-star hotel located next door.




Roger Radisson Street follows the route of the decumanus of Lugdunum, established in 43 BC, marking the start of the Via Aquitania. The aqueduct, dating from the 1st century, carried water from the Monts du Lyonnais to Lugdunum.




A PLACE WHERE DESIGN AND HISTORY INTERACT

The new Forum Fourvière event venue draws inspiration from Lyon's rich history. Designed as an extension of the Fourvière Hotel, it pays tribute to the city's ancient heritage by incorporating an iconic architectural feature: the remains of the Roman aqueduct of Gier, against which the building is built.

The visual identity of Forum Fourvière reflects this inspiration through a simple and elegant logo: a double 'F' monogram (Forum Fourvière) evoking both the symmetry of an aqueduct and the nobility of a Roman medal.

This common thread is also reflected in the interior design, which features high-quality materials and unique furniture in a natural colour palette. These aesthetic choices reinforce the coherence between the space, its history and its use.








DID YOU KNOW?

The ground treatment traces the route of the Roman aqueduct of the Gier, symbolising the path of the water. This undulation is punctuated by medallions on the ground representing 14 towns and villages crossed by the river; a route that ends in a spiral. This is itself inspired by the motifs found on ancient Roman columns.

THE SPACES OF THE FOURVIÈRE FORUM

THE CONVENTUS HALL



This plenary room, unique in Lyon, is called Conventus, evoking the idea of meeting and collaboration. With its 200 m² of floor space, it offers a generous and modular space that can be adapted to any configuration: theatre, classroom, pavé or cocktail. Its direct access to the 600 m² garden creates an exceptional setting. An ideal layout for complementing an outdoor event. Equipped for screenings and speeches, Conventus combines functionality and conviviality in a bright space with views through and panoramic vistas of La Confluence.

THE PRIVATUM ROOM

Located on the first floor of the Forum Fourvière, the 45 m² Privatum room has been specially designed for small committees. Its magnificent restored timber frame, breathtaking views and natural light give this venue an exceptional character. Modular and fully equipped, it offers the ideal setting to stimulate creativity and encourage confidential discussions.



THE GARDEN AND ITS WET FOOT




A true haven of greenery in the heart of Lyon, the private garden at Forum Fourvière covers more than 600 m². Surrounded by tall trees and plants, it offers a peaceful and unexpected setting in the heart of the city. To enjoy the outdoors in all seasons, an awning shelters the tables, perfect for al fresco dining. The garden also features a kiosk at its edge: a 'pied humide' (wet foot). This typically Lyonnais space adds an original touch to outdoor receptions.

DID YOU KNOW?

Pied humide (wet foot) is the nickname given in Lyon to the open-air bars in the capital of Gaul. These guinguettes consisted of a tin-covered counter, sheltered by a roof and wooden sides to protect against draughts. A raised floor kept the barmaid's feet dry, unlike the customers, who had their feet in the water when it rained, hence the name 'wet feet'. They were at their peak between the mid-19th century and the 1920s and 1930s.

Private secure car park with 72 spaces reserved for guests.





Integrated activities and leisure facilities, including a 25-metre swimming lane, wellness area with jacuzzi and steam room, boules court, terraces and gardens.
